The Woodridge Public Library is not responsible for any information found on the Internet other than the content of our own website. The Library accepts no responsibility for any loss or damages done directly or indirectly to personal data or equipment when using the computers.

Terms of Use

Failure to follow the attached terms may result in loss of computer privileges/possible legal action.

1. No patron may use another patron's library card in order to gain access to computers. Doing so will result in loss of computer privileges for both patrons.
2. Computers in the Adult/Young Adult Department may only be used by those 12 years and older.
3. Children who have not started 3rd grade must be accompanied on the computer by a parent or guardian.
4. No more than two people may sit at one computer at the same time. The person whose card is being used for the reservation is responsible for behavior while on the computer.
5. Computer users must not attempt to change settings, alter system security or otherwise damage the equipment.
6. Internet users may not use the Internet in any way that violates a Federal or State Law.
7. Computer users must not behave in a manner that is disruptive to other library patrons or library staff. This includes but is not limited to loud talking with others inside or outside the Computer Rooms, having the volume up too loud on the computers even with headphones, inappropriate use of furniture, and rudeness to library staff.
8. Internet users may not display or disseminate sexually explicit materials.
9. Internet users must not impersonate another person online.
10. Patrons must pay for all printing.
11. Computer users must relinquish the work station when their scheduled time has ended.
12. Only bottled water is allowed in public computer areas.
