

Free Wireless Access @ Woodridge Public Library

Free wireless Internet access (Wi-Fi) is available everywhere inside the library. You don't need a phone jack, a user name, or a password--just turn on your notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device and start surfing (software programs and printers are not accessible).

The Library does not guarantee connectivity or access speed. **Library staff members are unable to assist with configuring or troubleshooting your wireless device to work with the wireless network.** If you are having problems connecting, check for the following:

- The device's wireless card supports **802.11b/g**.
- **WEP** setting is *disabled*.
- **DHCP** setting is *enabled* (obtain an IP address automatically).
- Your wireless card is scanning for the strongest signal (if it has that option).

Wi-Fi users must agree to comply with the Library's **Wireless Network User Agreement**, which appears online, in order to connect to the network.

Please keep in mind! As with most public Wi-Fi networks, the Library's wireless network is **not** secure. The Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment or for wireless device configurations, security, or data files resulting from connection to the Library's network.
