
## Go to Learning Express Library



- Using your computer or tablet web browser, go to the Library's website at www.woodridgelibrary.org.
- 2. Click on the **Online Resources** button at the top of the Library's home page.
- 3. Scroll down the Online Resources page to theOnline Tutorials section; click on LearningExpress Library.
- As prompted, enter your *entire* Woodridge
  Library card barcode in order to connect to the
  LearningExpress Library website.

# Register for an account





You can browse the website without an account. However, you will need an account in order to use a practice test, tutorial, or eBook:

- Click on Register at the bottom-right of the
  LearningExpress Library home page.
- Fill out the account registration form. If you don't have or want to use an email address, click **Register without Email** to create your own username.
- When you're finished filling out the form, click
  Create Account. If you supplied an email address, you'll receive a confirmation email.



## **Select a Learning Center**



LearningExpress Library content is organized into categories, called Learning Centers:

- Learning Center buttons appear in the middle of the page; use the left/right arrows to scroll through them OR click on All Centers at the top of the page.
- 2. Click on a button OR on a Center name in the list to go to the Learning Center's home page.

### Select a Resource



Each Learning Center covers specific topics, called **Resources**:

- Browse through the Resources buttons in the middle of the page OR click on **Resources** at the top of the page.
- Click on a button or on a Resource name in the list.

# Select a practice test 😂 or tutorial 🚇 or eBook 🔞



Most Resources are broken down into subtopics listed on the left side of the page:

- Click on a subtopic to see the available tests, eBooks, and tutorials.
- 2. Click on a practice test, tutorial, or eBook.
- To begin a test, tutorial or eBook\*, click
  Launch (if you aren't already logged-in to your account, click Login to Use).




\*eBooks are Adobe PDF files that you download/save to your computer or tablet. <u>They are yours to keep.</u> In order to open the eBook, you'll need a PDF compatible software program or app, such as the free Adobe Reader, installed on your device.

## Save your place in a practice test or tutorial



You can save your place in a test or tutorial and then pick up where you left off – just click the **Save and Finish Later** button. Your place will be saved in your account. When you return to **LearningExpress Library** and sign in, you'll be able **Resume** it.


# **My Center**



Your account is called **My Center**. You can go to **My Center** using the **My Center** buttons and links that appear throughout the website. **My Center** has two sections:

- Portfolio: Tests and Tutorials lists your inprogress and completed tests and tutorials;
  Computer Courses lists your Computer
  Course videos; and eBooks lists the eBooks that you've accessed. ResumeHUB collects your résumé data, only if you've used the Great Résumés tutorial.
- Profile: Your registration information.

# Resume a practice test or tutorial



#### On the Portfolio Tests and Tutorials tabs:

- Tests and tutorials that you viewed, but didn't start are listed with options to **Start** or **Delete**.
- Tests and tutorials that you either started or completed will have an + next to the name; click the + to see the options to Resume or View Score Report..
- You can **Delete** any item from your account at any time; however, <u>all associated scores</u> and feedback will also be deleted!
