# Library Director's Report December 2021

We had our All Staff Meetings on December 10th. The building was closed from 9 - 1 and we took the opportunity to have department meetings and then have a low key, socially distant holiday celebration. There were multiple games, including bingo, and prizes and food. Cassie Gray, our Human Resources Manager, did the bulk of the work and planning for this, and did a very nice job.

We had a workshop on December 8th about insurance coverage as it relates to natural disasters, with a focus on the recent tornado in Woodridge. We provided this in conjunction with the Village of Woodridge, and with their assistance in both funding and marketing we had attendance of 74 people, which is outstanding for a topic of this nature. We received some very nice feedback from attendees about the program.
