Library Director's Report December 2022

More than 150 people have now viewed our virtual program on cutting cable costs and reducing robocalls and this is one of the programs that patrons can continue to access through our website's **Library Program Channel** links, which is an option on the "Attend" menu. The Rat Pack Holiday program attracted over 100 adults who enjoyed coming in for live music.

We really hit our stride with all ages and family programs that brought hundreds of patrons through the doors for holiday-inspired programs. The Sled Dog Meet & Greet allowed 600 patrons to interact with seven Siberian Huskies and several puppies, all with the help of 12 teen volunteers, volunteer dog-handlers, and our dog-loving staff. We had a nice turnout for Cookie Day (187) and we provided 45 decorating kits to the program staff at Cedarhurst Senior Living, allowing them to host a "ready-to-go" cookie program with the seniors in their Memory Care unit. More than 400 people including many tots and preschoolers turned out for the "Happy Noon Year" celebration and we are already strategizing for next year's balloon drop.
